

Removing Graffiti from LAMCOHPL

LAMCO^{HPL} surface is suitable to avoid most of damages coming from felt-tip pens, ballpoint pen ink, lipstick, spray paints, emulsion paints and various inks in general.

The closed structure of the surface doesn't allow a permanent adhesion of the above mentioned agents.

For this reason, no preventive anti-graffiti treatment is necessary.

If **LAMCO**^{HPL} surface should be damaged by graffiti, proceed in this way:

Use a detergent and/or a suitable organic solvent (acetone, ethyl alcohol, perchloroethylene, MEK-methyl ethyl Ketone, etc.).

Allow it to work for a short time according to the degree of the dirt. Remove the detergent or the organic solvent with a no abrasive sponge, rinse and wipe with a no abrasive paper/cloth.

The difficulty in removing graffiti may depend by the structure of the surface: in general smooth finishes are easier to clean than structured finishes.
